

## REPORT ON GANDHI JAYANTI CELEBRATIONS

Dispur Law College celebrated Gandhi Jayanti Divas with a host of programmes which included a Poster Making Competition, Plantation of trees in the Campus, Swachh Bharat Abhiyan and a Intra Moot Court Competition. Mr. Atul Bora, MLA, Dispur Constituency was the invited Guest of Honour.

The programme started with the inauguration of the Wall Magazine on Poster Making Competition. It was inaugurated by Sri Atul Bora, MLA. After the inauguration, the Hon'ble MLA spoke on the significance of creative art and creative writing and how these skills are necessary for the development of the students.

Then the hon'ble minister made a plantation within the campus of the college. Faculties of the College also made plantations within the campus pledged to look after the trees by regularly watering them with their own hands. The trees planted were "Bokul" and "Deodhar". Botanically known as *Mimusops elengi*. Bakul is a very beautiful tree. The tree bears creamy white fragrant flowers and ovoid berries. Bakula has fresh and sweet-smelling fragrance. It is an evergreen tree and it has distinctive appearance due to its dark bark with deep fissures. The Deodar cedar (*Cedrus deodara*) is an evergreen conifer tree that is

favoured for its weeping habit (gracefully drooping branches). The motto was to “Go Green” within the Campus with these beautiful trees.
