Brief Report: The programme started with an inaugural speech by Dr. Gargi Dutta Paul, Principal, Dispur Law College. On 24th September, Book review competition was held in which students were asked to select any book and then write a review of the book. On 25th September, Computer typing competition was held in which the participants were asked to open their respective PCs and type a given paragraph of 250 words within a time limit. On 26th September Magazine reading and review writing competition was held in which the participants were asked to choose one magazine out of the seven popular magazines and then write its review. On 27th September, Case search competition was held in which they were given few case citations and were asked to search them using the Law Journals. On 28th September, an extempore speech competition was held in the College auditorium in which the students were given different topics to speak within a time limit.
