Engagement in creative writing helps us to explore human experiences, share new ideas and stories with a wide audience advocate for a better society and the world a better place. Creative writing also helps to improve intellectual skills. The sentence structure, vocabulary and use of punctuation will be notably more advanced than others who do not practice creative writing. In a world where text messages speak and emojis are so common, creative writing helps to develop writing skills that are being forgotten about. If a person cannot communicate effectively, the problem may become worse as they grow older. Sharing ideas with others allows a person to develop their storyline and collaborate with others. Encouraging creative writing can help a person to communicate effectively in the technology world.

Writing helps to improve organization from a young age. By plotting out a story line, a person from a young age can help to develop organization and create drama or surprises in their story. This can then be applied to everyday tasks, helping them to improve their own organization and be prepared for the day ahead. Creative writing is not only a tool to help students unleash their creativity and feel more comfortable writing about and about everyday life, but it has also been shown to improve language learning.

Creative writing assignments allow students to discover their personality, express themselves artistically, use their imagination, and discover their writing style. It also helps in building confidence, artistic self-expression, thought clarification, better understanding of the mechanics of reading and writing, empathy and communication skills. At the university level and college level, creative writing is encouraged as teachers encourage their students to learn to write stories and expand their vocabulary in a non-academic way in an academic setting. In return, students also devote some of their (free) time to practice and discussing writing with each other. Students writing creatively are encouraged to participate in extracurricular writing-based activities such as editorial clubs, school literature or magazines, writing contests and continuing education courses.
