## *Dispur Law College at a Glance*

Dispur Law College was established in the year 1993. Aspiring to impart quality legal education, the College started functioning in the premises of Gopal Boro Govt. H.S. School, Dispur, on the 1st Feb, 1994. With the donations of the land adjacent to the historic Secretariat building of Assam by Late Madhuri Das, wife of Late Dharmananda Das, IAS (Retired) the then Chief Secretary of the Government of Assam and Sri Dalim Ch. Pathak, Advocate, the College was able to construct its own building. The foundation stone of the college building was laid by the then Chief Minister of Assam, Late Karmashree Hiteswar Saikia on 9th March, 1995. Since 1995, the College has been holding classes in its own permanent premises located in Dharmananda Das Avenue, Last Gate, Dispur.

After two decades of experience the College has established itself as an excellent legal institution in the whole of the North Eastern region. Dispur Law College has outstanding faculty and extraordinary gifted students and alumni. Its prodigious resources and its prime location at the heart of the capital of Assam, Dispur, contribute to its leading role in the regional legal education. The Dispur Law College aims at pioneering the legal aspirant with the spirit of competitiveness and innovation, enriching their knowledge, their self confidence and thereby expecting to acquire manifold qualities and knowledge not only of law but also of other disciplines which have relevance in understanding the socio-economic and political realities of today's contemporary world.

Permanently affiliated to Gauhati University, the College has been offering Three Year LL.B. Course. The College also offers Five Year (integrated) BA. LL.B course which is temporarily affiliated. The College has received Concurrence and No Objection from the Government of Assam.

Located at the proximity of the Assam Secretariat Building, the College is well connected to the Srimanta Sankardev path previously known as G.S. Road.

## ADMISSION GUIDELINES

Admission is purely on merit and is subject to availability of seats as per the directions issued by Gauhati University and the Bar Council of India from time to time. A transparent admission procedure is strictly followed based on the standard norms. The management of the College does not accept any donation or capitation fee for admission to any course offered by the College.

### Eligibility for admission: As per the Bar Council of India Rules

#### (a) Three Year Law Degree Course:

An applicant who has graduated in any discipline of knowledge from a University established "by an Act of Parliament or by a State legislature or an equivalent national institution recognized as a deemed to be University or a foreign University recognized as equivalent to the status of an Indian University by an authority competent to declare equivalence, may apply for a three years' degree program in law leading to conferment of LL.B. degree on successful completion of the regular program conducted by a University whose degree in law is recognized by the Bar Council of India for the purpose of enrolment."

#### (b) Integrated Law Degree Program:

An applicant who has successfully completed Senior Secondary School course ('+2') or equivalent (such as 11+1, 'A' level in Senior School Leaving Certificate Course) from a recognized University of India or outside or from a Senior Secondary Board or equivalent, constituted or recognized by the Union or by a State Government or from any equivalent institution from a foreign country recognized by the government of the country on successful completion of the course, may apply for and be admitted into the program of the Centers of Legal Education to obtain the integrated degree in law with a degree in any other subject as the first degree from the University whose such a degree in law is recognized by the Bar Council of India for the purpose of enrolment:

"Provided that applicants who have obtained + 2 Higher Secondary Pass Certificate or First Degree Certificate after prosecuting studies in distance or correspondence method shall also be considered as eligible for admission in the Integrated five years course or three years LL.B. course, as the case may be."

*Explanation-* The applicants who have obtained 10 + 2 or graduation/post graduation through open Universities system only without having any basic qualification for

prosecuting such studies are not eligible for admission in the law courses.

**Prohibition to register for two regular courses of study :** No student shall be allowed to simultaneously register for a law degree program with any other graduate or post-graduate or certificate course run by the same or any other University or an Institute for academic or professional learning excepting in the integrated degree program of the same institution: “Provided that any short period part time certificate course on language, computer science or computer application of an institute or any course run by a Centre for Distance Learning of a University however shall be exempted.”





### Admission Procedure for 5 year B.A., LL.B.

1. Application for admission into the college shall be made in the prescribed admission form issued by the College Office on payment of Rs.500/- only.
2. Application form, duly filled in, and accompanied by copies of all testimonials and documents as prescribed, must reach the College on or before the last date of submission as notified. Incomplete form shall not be entertained. Applications received after last date of submission shall be rejected.
3. Applicant shall also be able to take online admission through the procedure prescribed by the college from time to time on the College website.
- 4) **Minimum marks in qualifying examination for admission:** The required percentage of submission of application is not below 45% of total marks. In case of general category applicants, 42% for OBC category and 40% of the total marks for SC and ST to be obtained for the qualifying examination.  
Provided that such a minimum qualifying marks shall not automatically entitle a person to get admission into an institution.  
Age limit as prescribed by the Bar Council of India.
5. For offline admission, candidates are required to produce at the time of interview/admission the original copies of
  - (a) Certificates and Mark sheets of HSLC and HSSLC Examination.
  - (b) Character Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
  - (c) Caste Certificate, wherever necessary.
  - (d) 2 copies of passport size photographs.
6. Admission Committee shall have every right to refuse admission in appropriate cases.
7. In case of submission of forged documents or suppression of material facts by a student, detected even after admission, his/her admission will stand cancelled.

#### Scheme of Admission:

The selected candidates are required to appear for interview before the admission committee on the date specified in the website. The merit list on the basis of interview will be published. If two or more candidates obtain same marks in the interview, then the marks obtained in the qualifying examination shall be taken into consideration.

### Admission Procedure for 3 year LL. B. Course

1. Application for admission into the college shall be made in the prescribed admission form issued by the College Office on payment of Rs.500/- only.
2. Application form, duly filled in, and accompanied by copies of all testimonials and documents as prescribed, must reach the College on or before the last date of submission as notified. Incomplete form shall not be entertained. Applications received after last date of submission shall be rejected.
3. Applicant shall also be able to take online admission through the procedure prescribed by the college from time to time on the College website.
- 4) **Minimum marks in qualifying examination for admission:** The required percentage of submission of application is not below 45% of total marks. In case of general category applicants, 42% for OBC category and 40% of the total marks for SC and ST to be obtained for the qualifying examination.  
Provided that such a minimum qualifying marks shall not automatically entitle a person to get admission into an institution.  
Age limit as prescribed by the Bar Council of India.
5. For offline admission, candidates are required to produce at the time of interview/admission the original copies of-
  - (a) Certificates and Mark sheets from H.S.L.C. onwards upto Graduation.
  - (b) Character Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
  - (c) Caste Certificate, wherever necessary.
  - (d) 2 copies of passport size photographs.
6. Admission Committee shall have every right to refuse admission in appropriate cases.
7. In case of submission of forged documents or suppression of material facts by a student, detected even after admission, his/her admission will stand cancelled.

**Scheme of Admission:** The selected candidates are required to appear for interview before the admission committee on the date specified in the website. The merit list on the basis of interview will be published. If two or more candidates obtain same marks in the interview, then the marks obtained in the qualifying examination shall be taken into consideration.

### FEE STRUCTURE

Admission fee, Course fees, Student Welfare fee, Library Caution fees. Examination fees are required to be paid as Gauhati University Rules.





## INFRASTRUCTURE FACILITIES

The college has got spacious and well furnished class rooms with adequate open space within its premises in a calm and quiet atmosphere conducive for studies. There are separate common rooms for girls and boys and adequate number of toilets. The College has spacious Teachers' Common Room, a resourceful, well equipped Library with reading facilities, Legal Aid Clinic and Office Room for comfortable and smooth functioning of the college.

The classes are held regularly without any interruption and even off-the-class counselling are done by the teachers in case of need. Besides, the faculties also provide remedial/doubt clearing classes

## LIBRARY

The College Library is well equipped with spacious reading room and latest books and journals including internet facility. Two online legal database facility is also available for the students of the college. The library is looked after by experienced staff and students are expected to avail library facility for their academic and personality development by following the rules and regulation of the library.

Adequate number of books including some rare and precious publications on law, news papers, periodicals etc. are easily available to the students as well as the teachers to boost their knowledge. The reading hall is spacious enough to provide reading facilities to a good number of students. The students can borrow books from the library against their library cards issued by the College Library.

A non-transferable identity card is issued to each student at the time of admission. The card is renewed every semester and such identity card issued by the authority is to be brought to the college everyday and is to be produced when asked for. Students should maintain absolute discipline and silence while they are in the Library Reading Hall.

## DISPUR LAW COLLEGE DIGITAL LIBRARY

The College library has its own institutional Digital Repository which it has developed by taking clouds space of National Digital Library, Kharagpur (IIT Kharagpur) in which it has created metadata of question papers of 3 year LL.B., 5 year B.A., LL.B. & LL.M. examination.

The College library has Book Bank facility to provide educational support to the economically weaker students of every semester.

## LIBRARY CAUTION MONEY

Condition for refund of library caution money-

1. The student must clear all the semesters of the course of study.
2. He/She should have no books or other belongings of the library outstanding against him/her.
3. He/she should make an application to the Principal through the Librarian with the following documents-
  - (a) Photo copy of the Pass Certificate issued by the college.
  - (b) Photocopy of the 1st Semester admission receipt .

(c) Photocopy of the library clearance certificate.

Students are required to fill up a prescribed form available in the library, Dispur Law College.

### **COMPUTER & INTERNET :**

The College provides computer with internet facilities with Jio-Fiber leased line Plan to the students for updating them with modern and latest information. The online facility to access the Supreme Court cases are provided to the students for upgrading their knowledge and performance.

The Saraswati Puja, the Freshman Social, the College Week, Library week, Book Fair and Farewell function for the final year students are observed annually by the students. Different sport activities and extra curricular activities are undertaken during the college week for all round development of the students.

### **Achievements and Activities**

The student of Dispur Law College have excelled in academics. A number of students secured first class in 3 year LL.B. (Final) examination as well as 5 year B.A., LL.B./LL.B. (Hons) Final Examination held under Gauhati University. Apart from the academic field the students of Dispur Law College brought laurels to the college, in some other fields also.

The College hosted a numbers of programmes in the last year for holistic development of the students. A few of such programmes are - A Two-Day Workshop in the New Criminal Laws of India, Workshop on the use of Supreme Court Cases online, an Intra Moot Court Competition, Workshop on Power of Mind etc.

The college organised Legal Aid Camp in Amolighat, Bamungaon (Morigaon District) which is a remote area where the students rendered free legal aid to the needy residents under the guidance of the teachers.

## GENERAL RULES AND DISCIPLINE

- (i) Discipline is the essence of education and the students are expected to strive for and maintain high standard of discipline inside and outside the College.
- (ii) A student found guilty on the ground of misconduct, misdemeanor, violation of rules, unsatisfactory progress, irregular attendance, showing discourtesy to the teachers and staff member in any form, adoption of unfair means in the examination etc, or found indulging in any activities likely to affect the peaceful academic atmosphere of the college shall be liable to such disciplinary actions as the College Authority may deem fit and proper.
- (iii) The students admitted to the college must abide by all the rules and regulations as prescribed by the college authorities from time to time and as prescribed by Gauhati University.
- (iv) The Course of study in the College are full-time courses. No student can take any other fulltime course simultaneously.
- (v) Any notice desired to be pasted or circulated by the students anywhere in the College or holding of any meeting within the College premises will require prior permission of the College Authority.
- (vi) Students shall not loiter in the corridors or in front of the class rooms or office rooms or on the road in front of the College during their off periods. Students should devote their time quietly in the library and shall not cause any disturbance to others.
- (vii) Students shall be decently dressed whenever they are within the College premises.
- (viii) Maintenance of discipline is vested with the Head of the Institution whose decision shall be final in all such matters.
- (ix) Students are required to get themselves admitted in the next higher classes as soon as the academic session is completed.
- (x) Use of mobile phones during the class hour and in the examination hall is strictly prohibited.
- (xi) Students are advised to keep the College campus neat and clean and eco-friendly.
- (xii) Use of tobacco is strictly prohibited within the campus.
