Policy statement on Attendance Compliances

- 1. The required attendance to appear in the end semester examination in LL.B and B.A.LL.B Course is 70% (Rule 12 of the Legal Education Rules 2008 and Gauhati University Regulations for 3 year LL.B and 5 year B.A.LL.B course 2024)
- 2. Attendance shall include Moot Court Room exercise, Tutorials and Practical Training, Legal Aid Clinic (BCI Rule 12), representing the college in Moot Court Competitions, Seminars, Workshops, Legal and Camp, National State or Universities level Sports etc. (Gauhati University Regulations for 3 year Degree and 5 year Double Degree Integrated Course in Law 2010).
- 3. When a student has obtained 65% attendance in any subject and the student maintained at least 70% is all subject combine together, the student shall be allowed to appear in the end semester examination in exceptional circumstances. The Principal is required to record the reasons for granting attendance relaxation and forward the list to the Bar Council of India.
- 4. The students who do not fulfill the minimum attendance norm shall be notified by the mentor appointed for the semester at least 30 days prior to the end semester from fill up.
- 5. The students failing to fulfill the minimum attendance norm shall be required to fulfill the following requirements.
- a) to attend extra physical classes.
- b) to attend extra online classes.
- c) to submit home assignment to the teacher concerned.
