## *Dispur Law College at a Glance*

Dispur Law College was established in the year 1993. Aspiring to impart quality legal education, the College started functioning in the premises of Gopal Boro Govt. H.S. School, Dispur, on the 1st Feb, 1994. With donations of the land by Late Madhuri Das, wife of Late Dharmananda Das, IAS (Retired) the then Chief Secretary of the Government of Assam, the College was able to construct its own building at Last gate, Dispur. The foundation stone of the college building was laid by the then Chief Minister of Assam Late Karmashree Hiteswar Saikia on 9th March, 1995. Since 1995, the College has been holding classes in its own permanent premises located in Dharmananda Das Avenue, Last Gate, Dispur.

After two decades of experience the College has established itself as an excellent legal institution in the whole of the North Eastern region. Dispur Law College has outstanding faculty and extraordinary gifted students and alumni. Its prodigious resources and its prime location at the heart of the capital of Assam, Dispur, contribute to its leading role in the regional legal education. The Dispur Law College aims at pioneering the legal aspirant with the spirit of competitiveness and innovation, enriching their knowledge, their self confidence and thereby expecting to acquire manifold qualities and knowledge not only of law but also of other disciplines which have relevance in understanding the socio-economic and political realities of today's contemporary world.

The LL.B course offered by the college is permanently affiliated to Guahati University and has obtained the approval of affiliation from the Bar Council of India.

The B.A. LL.B course is also affiliated to Gauhati University and has obtained the approval of affiliation from Bar Council of India.

Located at the proximity of the Assam Secretariat Building, the College is well connected to the Srimanta Sankardev path previously known as G.S. Road.

### Admission Procedure for 5 year B.A. LL.B. & 3 year LL.B Course

1. Application for admission into the college shall be made in the prescribed admission form available in College website on payment of Rs.500/- only.
2. Application form, duly filled in, and accompanied by copies of all testimonials and documents as prescribed, must reach the College on or before the last date as notified. Incomplete form shall not be entertained.
3. Applicant shall take online admission through the procedure prescribed by the college from time to time.
- 4) The admission to LL.B and B.A.LL.B Programme is as per notification of the Bar Council of India and Gauhati University from time to time.

The minimum eligibility for admission to LL.B and B.A. LL.B programme is 45% marks for general candidates, 42% for OBC and 40% for SC and ST candidates in the qualifying examination.

5. The candidates are required to produce at the time of admission, the following original documents :
  - (a) Certificates and Mark sheets of qualifying Examination.
  - (b) Adhaar Card.
  - (c) Caste Certificate, wherever necessary.
  - (d) 2 copies of passport size photographs.
6. Admission Committee shall have every right to refuse admission in appropriate cases.
7. In case of submission of forged documents or suppression of material facts by a student, detected even after admission, his/her admission will stand cancelled.

The selected candidates are required to appear before the admission committee on the date specified in the website for document verification and admission.

The 1st and 2nd Sessional examination of odd semesters will be held in the second part of September and November respectively and the 1st and 2nd Sessional examination of the even semesters will be held in the second part of February and April respectively

Each sessional examination will be of 1 hour duration of total 20 marks in each paper.

### INFRASTRUCTURE FACILITIES

The College has got spacious and well furnished class rooms. There are separate common rooms for girls and boys and adequate number of toilets. The College has spacious Teachers' Common Room, Legal Aid Clinic and Office Room for comfortable and smooth functioning of the College.

### LIBRARY INFRASTRUCTURES

#### THE COLLEGE LIBRARY :

The College Library is situated on the ground floor of Block-2 on the east side of the campus and offers ample resources and study materials. The library is divided into two rooms totaling around 1760 square feet and equipped with internet and a foot traffic generator. The library is under CCTV surveillance. The library's printed resources include textbooks, reference books, commentaries, academic journals, reports, administrative reference books, encyclopedia, legal dictionaries, handbooks, digests, dissertations, moot memorials, six law journals, three popular competitive magazines, three English-language newspapers, one local-language newspaper, and three legal online databases. The students can borrow books from the library through a non-transferable library borrower's card issued by the library authority which is to be renewed every semester. The library also provides reference service to visiting readers from across the country.

#### E-RESOURCES:

The library has subscription to three legal databases name, AIR ONELINE, SCC ONLINE and LEXIS NEXIS to have access to E-books, case laws, national and international journal articles.

**BOOK PLAN:**

The College library includes a Book Bank for economically and socially disadvantaged students across all department. Students can borrow a set of up to four books on various subjects to use throughout academic semester. The books must be returned after the university examinations are completed. The library distributes a circular at the start of the session, and qualified students can apply to receive the benefit according to the schedule specified therein. Any defaulter in this context will not be supplied any additional books unless he or she pays the outstanding balance.

**LIBRARY CAUTION MONEY :**

Library also has the provision of refunding the Library Caution money to the students who qualify in all the semesters. Student are required to follow certain guidelines and submit the documents along with a prescribed application form available in the Librarian's desk.

**COMPUTER LABORATORY :**

The library has a computer lab with thirty Wi-Fi-enabled PCs connected to a Reliance Jio Internet Leased Line that are ready to work on computational tasks. The computer Lab allows users to access the institute's subscribed online legal databases. With a Reliance Jio Leased Line connection of the bandwidth of 20 mbps, every computer is linked to the Internet LAN. On all days that are open, as well as on holidays, when necessary, staff and students have access to computers with internet. Wi-Fi is accessible for browsing and, if needed, for conducting online classes.

**CCTV SURVEILLANCES**

The College campus (including every class room) is under CCTV Surveillance.

**BIO-METRICS ATTENDANCE**

Attendance of students are taken through Bio-Metrics machines

**MOOT COURT ROOM**

The College has spacious moot court room with all facilities for conducting moot trials.

**LEGAL AID CLINIC**

A legal Aid clinic is functioning from the college premises and a renovated legal clinic was inaugurated by Hon'ble Justice N Koteswar Singh, Judge, Gauhati High Court. Further, the Legal Aid Cell has adopted the Harijan Colony, Dispur, for giving legal aid. The College also organises Legal Aid Camp in remote areas of Assam to promote legal awareness.

### **FESTIVAL AND FUNCTIONS**

The Saraswati Puja, the Freshman Social, the College Week, Library week, Book Fair and Farewell function for the final year students are observed annually by the students. Different sport activities and extra curricular activities are undertaken during the college week for all round development of the students.

### **COLLEGE MAGAZINE AND WALL MAGAZINE**

The Dispur Law College Magazine is the medium of developing literary and other potentialities of the students. The Wall Magazine, 'UTTARAN' is an excellent expression of creativity of the students of the college. The College is also publishing an E-Magazine LITERARY DLICIAN at regular interval. Multi-disciplinary Peer reviewed E- Journal, 'Protibimbo...'. The Image (ISSN NO 2583-881) has also been published at regular interval.

### **CAREER GUIDANCE CELL**

There is a career guidance cell in the college which provides counseling on various career prospects to the students.

### **STUDENTS' ASSOCIATION**

The College gives importance to the development of character, personality and leadership ability of all students. The College considers co-curricular and extra curricular activities essential for all round development of law students in the College. ## GENERAL RULES AND DISCIPLINE

- (i) Discipline is the essence of education and the students are expected to strive for and maintain high standard of discipline inside and outside the College.
- (ii) A students found guilty on the ground of misconduct, misdemeanor, violation of rules, unsatisfactory progress, irregular attendance, showing discourtesy to the teachers and staff member in any form, adoption of unfair means in the examination etc, or found indulging in any activities likely to affect the peaceful academic atmosphere of the college shall be liable to such disciplinary actions as the College Authority may deem fit and proper.
- (iii) The students admitted to the college must abide by all the rules and regulations as prescribed by the college authorities from time to time and as prescribed by the G.U.
- (iv) The Course of study in the College are full-time courses. No student can take any other fulltime course simultaneously.
- (v) Any notice desired to be pasted or circulated by the students anywhere in the College or holding of any meeting within the college premises will require prior permission of the College Authority.
- (vi) Students shall not loiter in the corridors or in front of the class rooms or office rooms or on the road in front of the College during their off periods. Students should devote their time quietly in the library and shall not cause any disturbance to others.
- (vii) Students shall be decently dressed whenever they are within the College premises.
- (viii) Maintenance of discipline is vested within the Head of the Institution whose decision shall be final in all such matters.
- (ix) Students are required to get themselves admitted in the next higher classes as soon as the academic session is completed.
- (x) Use of mobile phones during the classes and in the examination hall is strictly prohibited.
- (xi) Students are advised to keep the college campus neat and clean and eco-friendly.
- (xii) Use of tobacco is strictly prohibited within the campus.
