Resolution of the meeting held on 19th October, 2023

1. The meeting was presided over by Dr. Ramesh Ch Barpatra Gohain, President, GB, Dispur Law College to discuss the upcoming National Seminar to be organized by IQAC Dispur Law College.
2. All the members present proposed to organize the National Seminar on 2nd and 3rd February, 2024.
3. President, GB proposed to organize the inaugural ceremony and the technical session in the college premises and college auditorium.
4. The Convenor of the seminar, Dr. Swapna Manindranath Deka shall write the concept note of the seminar within the 1st week of November, 2023.
5. The meeting asked Dr. Jintu Borah to prepare the brochure and Call for Paper of the seminar at the earliest possibility as the full paper will be collected by 31st December, 2023. Submission of paper shall be as per UGC norms (Multidisciplinary).
6. The meeting decided that the seminar will be in offline mode.
7. The meeting decided to make sub-committees for doing different tasks of the seminar. President, GB suggested to search rapporteurs for every session.
8. The meeting decided that paper contributors shall not be allowed to read the paper but only highlight the bullet points.
9. President, GB has suggested to organize the seminar under the provision of the following bare acts:
 - i. The Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Sites and Remains Act, 1958 (24 of 1958)
 - ii. The Ancient Monuments Preservation Act, 1904 (7 of 1904)
 - iii. The Madras Ancient and Historical Monument and Archaeological Sites and Remains Act, 1966 (Madras Act 25 of 1966)
 - iv. Assam Heritage (Tangible) protection, preservation, conservation and maintenance act, 2020
 - v. Right to Public Service act, 2012
 - vi. Protection of Human Rights Act, 1993 (sec 12 f,g,h)
 - vii. Commission of Protection of Child Rights Act, 2005.

10. The President, GB has suggested the following concepts to include in the themes:

- i. Environment
- ii. Tribal customary laws and tribal tradition
- iii. Traditional Intellectual Property Rights
- iv. Rights of land
- v. Laws of war
- vi. Migration
- vii. Interpretation: Traditional method of interpretation (theory of Nyaya, Mimansa)
