

**COMMON ADMISSION TEST (CAT-2026) FOR 3-YEAR LAW PROGRAMME, 2026**  
(Conducted by Gauhati University for all Universities of Assam, except Dibrugarh University)

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

**Eligibility Criteria:**

1. A degree (graduation) in any discipline or any equivalent qualification from any recognized University with a minimum percentage of marks not below 45% of the total marks in case of UR/EWS category applicants, 42% of the total marks in case of OBC/MOBC category applicants and 40% of the total marks in case of SC, ST(P), ST(H) category applicants.
2. Additionally, those who are **appearing or have appeared** in the final **UG degree** examination and whose **final results are awaited** are also eligible to appear in the ASSAM CAT-2026, provided that, in the event of selection, they shall have to submit their final results at the time of admission.
